To Athletic Director and Golf Coaches:

The purpose of this letter is to provide key dates and general rules for the Spring 2026 Virginia Independent Schools Athletic Association (VISAA) Varsity Golf season.

The VSGA will host rules seminars throughout the spring. Coaches, parents, and players can check the VSGA website for dates (<https://vsga.org>).

Each division has a contact throughout the season. Division I: Coach Marc Hogan (marc_hogan@woodberry.org); Division II: Coach Brandon Deane (bdeane@blueridgeschool.com); Division III: Coach Keith Green (kgreen@kenston.org). Girls Tournament: Coach Dennis McGowan (dmcgowan@pvipanther.net).

The VISAA State Co-Ed Golf State Championship will be held on May 11th, 2026 at Williamsburg National Golf Club, Yorktown Course, 3700 Centerville Road, Williamsburg, VA 23188. The rain date is May 14th.

For the co-ed State Championship, the VISAA Committee will rank teams based on scores within the three divisions beginning March 30th. The final ranking will be released on May 6th, 2026. The top 6 teams in each Division will be invited to the State tournament. The top 4 players in each division not on an invited team will be invited as an individual. Coaches are strongly encouraged to keep track of individual scores, including course rating and slope, as these are criteria the selection committee will use to make selections. Coaches will nominate individuals; the committee will announce individual selections on May 7th (after the teams are selected).

The cost will be \$31 per player. This does not include lunch. Payments must be paid prior to the first tee time. Practice rounds will be available on May 10th (after 1:00 PM) The cost is \$38 for walking or \$48 riding. Contact the Williamsburg National Pro shop for tee times.

The second annual Girl's State Championship will be held at Williamsburg National Golf Club, Yorktown Course, on May 12th. The rain date is May 13th. Tournament guidance:

- To be eligible for the girls' team championship, a school must have a girls' team that is composed of at least four players.
 - A girl may compete in both the VISAA girls' team championship and play on a VISAA co-ed team.
 - A girls' team must compete in a minimum of four matches on four different dates to be eligible to participate in the girls' state team tournament.
 - Match results will be reported on a reporting form.
 - The VISAA Committee will select the best 8 teams with 6 players and the best 12 individuals not on an invited team.

- The VISA Committee will announce how many teams and individuals will be selected once the season starts and the number of teams and players are known. The teams and individuals will be announced by the committee will announce teams on May 6th. Coaches are strongly encouraged to keep track of individual scores, including course rating and slope, as these are criteria the selection committee will use to make selections. Coaches will nominate individuals; the committee will announce individual selections on May 7th (after the teams are selected).
- The cost will be \$31 per player. This does not include lunch. Payments must be paid prior to the first tee time. Practice rounds will be available on May 10th (after 1:00 PM) The cost is \$38 for walking or \$48 riding. Contact the Williamsburg National Pro shop for tee times.

Teams and individuals must complete a minimum 6 matches to be eligible for the state championship. Coaches must report match scores by 9:00 PM Saturday evening. Scores will be used to select teams and individuals. Handicaps will not be utilized.

- If you play multiple opponents in a single match, you must fill out a separate form for each opponent as if each is a separate match. Please do not enter multiple opponents on an individual form submission.
- Failure to submit scores will disqualify the team from participating in the state championship.
- Boys should play from 6500–6700 yards; girls should play from 5500-5700 yards.
